- 1. Recognize their peer candidates and know enough about them to vote.*
 - 2. Understand the voting process and timelines.*
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Overview

You will use today's Tribe Time to view student government candidates for next year with your tribe and explain the voting process. There are 10 6th and 7th grade candidates and 12 8th grade candidates. The videos can be found on the school website where the daily news broadcast is shown.

Showing the Videos

Start by showing the videos of your tribe's grade. Ask them to decide (individually, not as a class) whom they are voting for before showing the other grades' videos. Show all three grades just so they are familiar with all of the students running – and it's fun to see all of their creativity. After showing all of the videos, explain the voting process as explained below.

Voting

Voting will open on Tuesday and students will be given time to vote in their social studies class on Wednesday by going to the school website under **Students > Class Elections 2018**. Regardless of whether they vote at home on Tuesday or in class on Wednesday, it will all be online at the same location. It's tied to their school account, so they won't be able to vote more than once. Winners will be announced later that week.
