Materials

Plain, white sheet of paper for each student.

Introduction

There have been far too many things this past school year to recap them all in one place, so we're going to try and just have you remember and share the best parts. And then compete.

Activity 1 – Refection Perfection

Using your blank piece of paper, think of one thing you've learned this year that has made the biggest difference to you. This can be a person, an event, a lesson, an activity, or really anything that sums up the best of your year for you. Using whatever form you feel most comfortable with, be it drawing, coloring, poetry (really), a well-worded story, or whatever else you think of, make something to share that experience with the rest of the class. Take about 10 minutes to do this, and then go around and share what you've created with the class. Be sure to put your name and tribe on the back so we can get it back to you if you want it.

Have the class choose the most creative or poignant reflection and bring it down to the office. We'll display it in the hallway for the next week and return it to them at the last Tribe Time.

Activity 2 – Tribe Time Games, Part Deux

One of the things we learned was that the Tribe Time Games were something we absolutely needed more of. We have a class set of \$5 gift certificates to Big J's and we want to give them away to one of the tribes. Here's your assignment: Have your teacher log on to their faculty canvas account and go to the PJH Faculty 17-18 class (not the one for the district).
